## **DENNIS STAGLIANO'S SARATOGA PICKS FOR TODAY**

### **BEST BET – RACE 8 – #3 FULLY SUBSCRIBED**

Fully Subscribed appears to have found an ideal opportunity to add another stakes victory to an already impressive résumé. Chad Brown has expertly managed this filly throughout her campaign, and she enters today's feature in outstanding form after consistently competing against quality company. Her versatility is perhaps her greatest weapon. She can stalk just behind the pace, sit farther back if necessary, or move earlier should the pace prove slower than expected. That flexibility gives Flavien Prat numerous tactical options from the moment the gates open.

The projected pace should be honest with Scottish Lassie and Bless the Broken both possessing enough early speed to ensure a legitimate tempo. That scenario plays directly into Fully Subscribed's strengths. Rather than becoming involved in an early speed duel, Prat should be able to save ground entering the first turn before gradually asking his mount to improve approaching the far turn.

Scottish Lassie deserves tremendous respect and could certainly win with her best effort, while Bless the Broken continues moving forward for Brad Cox and remains a major threat. Snowyte also owns enough class to complete the exotics. Still, Fully Subscribed combines class, consistency, tactical speed and finishing power better than anyone in this field. Everything points toward another polished performance, making **#3 Fully Subscribed** today's **Best Bet**.

### **BEST VALUE PLAY – RACE 5 – #10 SWAGING**

Swaging represents exactly the kind of horse value-conscious bettors should gravitate toward. Linda Rice has placed this gelding realistically throughout the season, and the recent performances suggest another winning effort could easily be forthcoming. Jaime Rodriguez draws the assignment and should have several tactical options leaving the gate, particularly from an outside post that minimizes the possibility of traffic while allowing Swaging to settle comfortably behind the leaders.

Sports Hero appears to be the logical challenger after competing well against similar company, while Tedder continues developing and possesses enough upside to improve once again. Diamond Child also owns enough natural speed to remain competitive throughout the race. Nevertheless, Swaging enters in steadily improving form and has repeatedly demonstrated the consistency required to win races at this level.

His expected odds make him considerably more attractive than several shorter-priced rivals. Horses offering this combination of current form and wagering value frequently become the key to profitable exactas, trifectas and superfectas. Swaging receives the nod as today's **Best Value Play**.

## LIVE LONGSHOT – RACE 3 – #9 SOUNDBITE

Soundbite is the overlooked runner capable of producing the afternoon's biggest surprise. Michelle Nevin reunites this veteran gelding with Irad Ortiz Jr., and that rider change alone makes this horse far more dangerous than the morning line indicates. While recent running lines appear ordinary at first glance, they came against stronger company and under pace scenarios that simply did not complement his late-running style.

Today's race projects much differently. Several horses possess enough early speed to create contested fractions through the opening half-mile. If that materializes, Soundbite becomes increasingly dangerous entering the far turn. His best races have come when allowed to settle comfortably before producing one sustained rally through the stretch.

My Gun's Loaded deserves favorite status and Nycon continues improving, but longshots become live when pace and trip fall into place. Soundbite owns precisely that profile today and should be included prominently in every exotic wager.

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## RACE 1 – Top 4 Picks: 7-2-8-3

Two by Two by Two deserves top billing after facing stronger company while displaying the tactical speed and professionalism expected from a Brad Cox trainee. Irad Ortiz Jr. should have every opportunity to establish ideal stalking position before asking for her best run approaching the quarter pole. **#2 Babcie** has steadily improved for Melanie Giddings and appears to be the primary challenger after showing enough early foot to secure excellent position throughout. **#8 Oath** exits competitive races for Linda Rice and has enough natural speed to remain within striking distance from start to finish. **#3 Hanna's Hideaway** rounds out the selections after showing flashes of ability that suggest another forward move is possible against this field.

## RACE 2 – Top 4 Picks: 7-3-5-2

Just Peachy receives a slight edge in this competitive juvenile maiden after attracting Flavien Prat for Rodolphe Brisset. Her morning preparation suggests considerable talent, and this filly appears bred to appreciate both today's distance and the Saratoga inner turf course. **#3 Conflict** represents the major danger while making her debut for Brad Cox and Irad Ortiz Jr., a combination that consistently demands respect in maiden races. **#5 Margie's Girl** owns an attractive pedigree for grass racing and should improve with experience, while **#2 Mandy Steph** has trained steadily for Miguel Clement and possesses enough upside to threaten if she receives a clean trip. Expect a closely contested finish among these four promising youngsters.

## RACE 3 – Top 4 Picks: 6-3-1-9

My Gun's Loaded enters as the deserving favorite after consistently producing strong speed figures while competing against quality allowance company. Chad Brown and Manuel Franco have this filly in outstanding form, and today's pace scenario should allow her to secure an ideal stalking position before making her winning move entering the stretch. **#3 Nycon** continues progressing for D. Whitworth Beckman and appears capable of providing the stiffest challenge. **#1 Brunch With Amy** benefits from drawing the rail and should save valuable ground throughout, while **#9 Soundbite** earns Live Longshot honors after returning to a field that better suits his closing style with Irad Ortiz Jr. aboard.

## RACE 4 – Top 4 Picks: 1-7-8-6

Glen Airy looks ready to capitalize on a favorable class drop after facing tougher competition throughout much of the season. Michael Maker and Irad Ortiz Jr. form one of Saratoga's strongest trainer-rider combinations, and the rail draw should allow Glen Airy to secure excellent position without expending unnecessary energy. **#7 Rungius** possesses enough tactical speed to remain within striking distance throughout and appears to be the primary danger. **#8 Neon Bordeaux** has enough late kick to benefit if the leaders soften one another, while **#6 Hours in a Day** has consistently picked up checks against similar company and deserves inclusion in all superfecta tickets.

#### **RACE 5 – Top 4 Picks: 10-7-11-4**

Swaging receives top billing after showing steadily improving form and now appears ideally placed to return to the winner's circle.
