RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS**Race 1 – 1 Mile (Dirt) – Purse \$40,000 – Claiming \$16,000****Wager Types:** Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta**Top 4 Picks: #1 Tabeguache, #5 Golden Purchase, #6 Swaggish, #3 Costa Terra**

#1 Tabeguache drops back to the claiming ranks after flashing speed and tiring in a tougher \$32K starter allowance. He was claimed that day and now returns for a barn that wins at a 24% clip off the claim, with solid works in the interim. The return to a one-turn mile suits his tactical speed, and Prat taking the call adds confidence. **#5 Golden Purchase** comes in off a visually impressive 8-length romp while stepping up off the claim. He retains Dylan Davis, and while the jump in class is steep, his last-out 76 Beyer towers over this group. **#6 Swaggish** returned from a layoff with a strong runner-up effort at this level, then was protected in a waiver spot. The drop back to open claiming signals intent, and his early foot could get him first run. **#3 Costa Terra** exits a similar spot where he chased a lively pace and tired. Second off the bench, he's eligible to move forward while cutting back from a two-turn try to a one-turn configuration where he's done better in the past.

#5 Summer Whirl ran evenly on turf in both starts but now moves to dirt, a surface she is bred to prefer (by Summer Front out of a Malibu Moon mare). Linda Rice is 25% with turf-to-dirt moves and has had success with this type at the meet. Bullet half-mile breeze over the Oklahoma training track on July 30 signals readiness. **#4 Capital Gal** returns from a six-month break and was protected last out in a turf sprint at Finger Lakes. She's shown some tactical speed, and her dam was a debut dirt winner. J/T combo of Handal and Davis hits at 29%. **#6 Rodeo Star** clipped heels and lost rider positioning last out—toss that effort. Two back, she showed potential with a decent closing kick on a sealed track. **#1 Cara's Dreamweaver** adds Lasix, debuts for a capable barn, and boasts a productive female family—logical to round out exotics.

Race 3 – 6 Furlongs (Dirt) – Purse \$35,000 – Claiming \$12,500 (Fillies & Mares 3+)**Wager Types:** Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Pick 3**Top 4 Picks: #1 Whistler's Style, #1AA Miss Lao, #3 Mursal, #4 Floge**

#1 Whistler's Style goes out for Linda Rice, who is winning at 25% with claiming runners this meet. She drops to the lowest level of her career and is back to a preferred sprint distance—her last time at this level was a solid third. She's a logical pace presence from the rail. **#1AA Miss Lao**, the entrymate, adds blinkers today after getting shuffled last time; she now cuts back to 6 furlongs, and Rice is strong with blinkers-on moves. **#3 Mursal** switches to a high-percentage barn that's 22% first off the claim and has fired solid efforts at this level. She's tactical enough to sit just off the speed and pounce. **#4 Floge** adds Lasix again and returns to a fast track for the first time in three starts—her win at Aqueduct in May makes her usable if she finds clear sailing.

#6 Bernt Again has posted competitive Beyers at this level and exits a strong second-place finish in an off-turf race over this surface. She cuts back to her best distance (3-for-6 at 6f) and switches to a hot jockey-trainer combo. The pace scenario also suits her stalking style. **#8 Red Burgundy** is lightly raced and returns off a brief layoff after showing promise last fall. Her lone win came with Santana aboard, who climbs back on today, and she has a versatile style that can adapt to pace flow. **#3 Brocknardini** adds Lasix for the first time and has solid back class from open allowance ranks. Her off-the-pace style fits a race with multiple speeds. **#1 Slightly Busy** returns to dirt after two turf tries and could get a favorable trip from the rail—dangerous if she reverts to prior sprint form.

#9 Lollipops was a respectable fourth facing winners for the first time after her maiden-breaking score and earned a career-best 69 Beyer in the process. She posted a sharp half-mile breeze since and now returns to sprinting, which looks like her preferred game. The outside post and rider switch to Franco are positives. **#4 Ragtime Sizzle** disappointed last out, but her previous figures (74, 73 Beyers) are very competitive here. She should get a stalking trip and may benefit from the slight class drop and dry surface. **#1 Another Cleeshay** wired maiden claimers in her debut at Saratoga last year and has been freshened. She returns for a barn that wins with 16% of their runners off layoffs and owns back numbers that fit. **#2 Handle On You** cuts back in distance and gets back to a fast track after a pair of sloppy track races—watch for improvement second off the bench.

#3 Always in Play debuts for Tom Morley with a pedigree that leans strongly turf—she's a half to multiple winners and her dam has produced three grass winners. She's working steadily and attracts Luis Saez, who wins 19% for this barn. **#10 Great Actress** outran her odds in a solid third-place debut at this level going a mile on turf. She returns off a

month's rest with a positive turf pedigree and has posted a sharp drill since. Logical contender. **#9 Oscar's Encore** had a slow start in her debut but showed a bit of interest late; her dam was stakes-placed on turf and this Canadian-bred appears well-meant with Lasix added. **#1 Winrooski** draws inside, adds blinkers, and stretches out for a barn that hits with a sneaky 15% second-time turf starters.

Race 7 – 1 Mile (Dirt) – Purse \$55,000 – Starter Allowance \$50,000 (3YO & Up)

Wager Types: Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Pick 4

Top 4 Picks: #2 Parchment Party, #1 Strapped, #6 Digital Ops, #5 Time for Trouble

#2 Parchment Party posted a career-best 84 Beyer in a sharp wire-to-wire win over this track at the same distance. He has tactical speed, and the rail draw of main pace rivals may allow him a favorable pressing trip outside. **#1 Strapped** is ultra-consistent and has hit the board in 10 of his last 12 starts. Though win-shy, he owns two local wins and benefits from rail draw and class relief. **#6 Digital Ops** set the pace and tired behind a pair of strong closers last out—expect a more patient ride today. He owns a 5:2-2-0 record at the mile distance. **#5 Time for Trouble** cuts back from a pair of 9-furlong efforts and may get overlooked—his best races stack up nicely here.

Race 8 – 1 1/16 Miles (Inner Turf) – Purse \$115,000 – Allowance NW1X (Fillies & Mares 3+)

Off Turf Picks: 5-4-3-2-1

Top 4 Picks: #7 Griselda (FR), #5 Midway Memories, #1 Stillthinkingofyou, #3 So Darn Pretty (IRE)

#7 Griselda (FR) returns for Chad Brown off a 10-month layoff but showed talent last fall when second in her U.S. debut at Aqueduct. The workout pattern suggests fitness, and Brown is 26% off long layoffs. She owns a strong Euro turf pedigree. **#5 Midway Memories** stumbled badly in her return from a break and was eased, but her previous form was solid, and she reunites with Irad Ortiz Jr., who was aboard for her win two back. **#1 Stillthinkingofyou** adds Lasix and may sit a cozy rail trip with the ability to finish; she's 2-for-2 ITM at the distance. **#3 So Darn Pretty (IRE)** gets a rider upgrade and was off slowly in her last turf try. Adds blinkers and Lasix, both positive changes.

Race 9 – 5 ½ Furlongs (Outer Turf) – Purse \$90,000 – Maiden Special Weight (NY-Bred Fillies & Mares 3+)

Wager Types: Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Grand Slam

Off Turf Picks: 5-3-2-10-4

Top 4 Picks: #10 St. Brigid's Cross, #11 Trading Trouble, #4 Setting Sun, #3 Peace of Gold

#10 St. Brigid's Cross was sluggish early on debut at Gulfstream but showed some late interest in a race where she wasn't fully cranked. Trainer George Weaver is 8-for-9 with second-time turf sprinters off 60–250 day layoffs, with winners averaging over \$15 payouts. Huge form stat. **#11 Trading Trouble** needs a scratch to draw in but ran well in her debut here earlier in the meet despite breaking inward into the gate. Has a bullet work since and is a must-use if she draws in. **#4 Setting Sun** has high-percentage turf connections (Prat/Brisset), and her full-sibling is a stakes winner on grass. Expect improvement second time out. **#3 Peace of Gold** has run evenly in both career starts and now adds blinkers for a barn that can pop with third-time starters.
